

Symbol for Plant Containment



- 1. Post the symbol on any greenhouse room, growth chamber, lab door, or on paper where the plant research requires containment.*
- 2. Containment can be a result of many factors: transgenic via NIH or local guidelines (e.g. BLx-P), regulated material (eg. USDA-APHIS-PPQ permitted), quarantine (State of xx Noxious Weed), etc.*
- 3. If the plant research does present a risk to human health, then feel free to use the Universal Biohazard Symbol alone or in addition to the plant symbol.*
- 4. Feel free to add text i.e. 'containment' to clarify the activity.*
